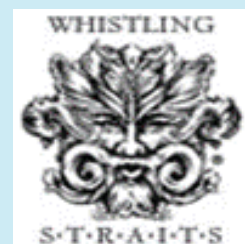

MONDAY, JUNE 4TH:	Golf at the River Course at Blackwolf Run - Round 1 (cart included) Welcome reception with open bar and full dinner
TUESDAY, JUNE 5TH:	Golf at the Irish Course at Whistling Straits - Round 2 (caddies not included)
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 6TH:	Golf at the Straits Course at Whistling Straits - Round 3 (caddies not included) Dinner & Awards Banquet beginning at 7 PM
THURSDAY, JUNE 7TH:	Checkout and depart from the Inn on Woodlake (individuals are to make their own arrangements).

River Course

River course is one of the most challenging and scenic destinations in North America. GOLF Magazine says this course “must be considered the nation’s finest public-access course of modern times.”

The River course at Blackwolf Run was ranked #15 in Golf Digest’s ranking of America’s 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses for 2011/2012. In 2012, the River Course will host the 2012 US Women’s Open.



Irish Course

Just inland from the great lake and built between four meandering streams, the grassland-and-dunes aspect of the Irish is a deceptively tranquil landscape. Both traditional and memorable, the Irish is full of unique challenges.

The Irish course is ranked # 35 in Golf Digest’s ranking of America’s 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses for 2011/2012.



Straits Course

Open, rugged and windswept terrain defines the walking-only, links-style Straits Course sculpted along two miles of Lake Michigan shoreline. A masterpiece in the world of golf created by Pete Dye, Straits course at Whistling Straits was ranked # 3 in Golf Digest’s ranking of America’s 100 Greatest Public Golf Courses for 2011/2012, and was host to the 2010 PGA Championship. Future events to be held on the Straits course include the 2015 PGA Championship, and 2020 Ryder Cup.

Inn on Woodlake

Located on the shore of picturesque Wood Lake, this serene 121-room hotel announces a renovation boasting boutique style guest rooms, all new meeting space as well as amenities and common areas for leisure and business travelers. Voted 2011 Best Resort Courses, and Award for Excellence.
