

South Florida PGA Frequently Asked Questions

How do I contact the Junior Golf Coordinator?

How do I register for membership?

To register for membership you need to locate the Player's Club login box here, and click new member sign up now. Please complete the entire membership application, including tournament experience with scores. Applications are not complete unless you have listed your previous tournament scores, listing just the tour you participated on is not sufficient.

How much is membership?

The 2012 membership fee is \$45.

Who is eligible for membership?

The South Florida PGA Junior Tour is open to junior golfers age 12-18. Tour members must reside within the South Florida Section boundaries, which include the following counties: Indian River, Highlands, Okeechobee, St. Lucie, Martin, Palm Beach, Broward, Miami-Dade, Monroe, Collier, Hendry, Lee, Charlotte, Glades, the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico.

Members are eligible based on age and ability. Previous tournament scores are required to determine if the player is eligible for the Junior Tour.

How long does approval take for a new membership?

Membership approvals take up to 5 business days. Please note if the application is not complete, membership will be pending until all of the appropriate information is provided. Tournament experience, including scores, must be listed in order for the application to be considered.*

Do I need to pass a rules quiz?

Players must pass a rules quiz prior to registering for a tournament. There are two different rules quizzes depending on your age; 12-13 and 14-18. If a player moves from the 12-13 division into the 14-18 division during the course of a season, they will be prompted to pass the proper rules quiz prior to being allowed to register for that event.

When do tournaments open for registration?

Registration for each tournament will open 8 weeks prior to the start of that event.

How do I register for a tournament?

All tournament registrations must be done online.

What does it mean when the tournament is full?

When the tournament is listed as full on the schedule, it means that both the event and wait list are full.

How can I be added to a wait list?

The ONLY way to register for a wait list is online. If the tournament says full, it means that the wait list is full as well. However, we do receive cancellations as time passes, and we encourage players interested in a particular event to check the website as space may open up.

How do I withdraw from a tournament?

The ONLY way to withdraw from a tournament is to email the Junior Golf Coordinator at mschechter@pgahq.com. Canceling through BlueGolf is not acceptable.

Are Caddies allowed?

Caddies are not permitted at any South Florida PGA Junior Tour event. Any player receiving advice during the competition round will be subject to Rule 8-1.

Are pull carts allowed?

Pull carts are allowed based on course approval.

Are rangefinders allowed?

Distance measuring devices are allowed when measuring distance only. However, if a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such functions are actually used.

How are the tournaments ranked?

All events are ranked by Junior Golf Scoreboard. In addition, the AJGA has awarded performance stars for the Overall Winners of our events. For more information about the AJGA performance stars [click here](#).

How do I qualify for the Tour Championship?
